A letter to the local governments was sent December, 2007 regarding the Local Update of Census Addresses program, also known as LUCA. If you have missed the deadline of December 31, 2007 please work with your respective counties which have registered and will may receive every address from the Census. The Northeast Florida Regional Council will be available to host an additional workshop, if requested, and also provide support assistance in the review of the addresses upon request. We are also providing our local governments with some tips which are listed below.

- **Keep and use the preaddressed prepaid Fed Ex envelope that came with the LUCA address materials.**
- **Those using ESRI ArcView, etc, and the free Census Tools Extension may enjoy reading the ESRI LUCA users forum. Lots of good answers posted on their by ESRI for issues encountered when working with LUCA address databases and maps. A link to it appears on the Forum under the thread topic "Software."**
- **Also there is a Florida LUCA Forum that anyone can browse and that those who register can post questions or give advice and solutions.**
- **Get to it at luca.flcensus.gov, and click on the yellow join the LUCA Forum button. The site has loads of resources.**
