1. **Rural Land Conversion to Urban Land Uses:** How successful have the policies in the Comprehensive Plan been in preserving and diversifying Putnam County's active crop land and Silviculture lands?
2. **Protection of the Natural Environment:** How successful has the County's Comprehensive Plan been in addressing wildlife corridors, opportunities to implement programs and land preservation of wildlife habitats?
3. **Energy:** How effective has the Comprehensive Plan been in addressing energy and in encouraging related programs such as Energy Star?
4. **Water:** How effective has the Comprehensive Plan been in addressing water conservation and in encouraging related programs such as Water Star?
5. **Economic Development:** How has the County used land use polices and decisions to encourage economic development?
6. **Land use and the St. Johns River:** How successful has Putnam County's Comprehensive Plan been in keeping appropriate land uses adjacent to the St. Johns River as well as other significant water bodies?
7. **Transportation Issue 1:** How effective has Putnam County's Comprehensive Plan been in addressing concurrency issues, especially on Strategic Intermodal System (SIS) facilities?
8. **Transportation Issue 2:** How effective are the Comprehensive Plan's policies in addressing the long term transportation needs of Putnam County?
9. **Infrastructure:** How successful has Putnam County's implementation of the Comprehensive Plan's policies been in achieving its potable water quantity and quality objectives (including stormwater drainage).
10. **Rural Centers:** To what extent are the existing Rural Centers still viable as a land use concept in Putnam County's Comprehensive Plan?
