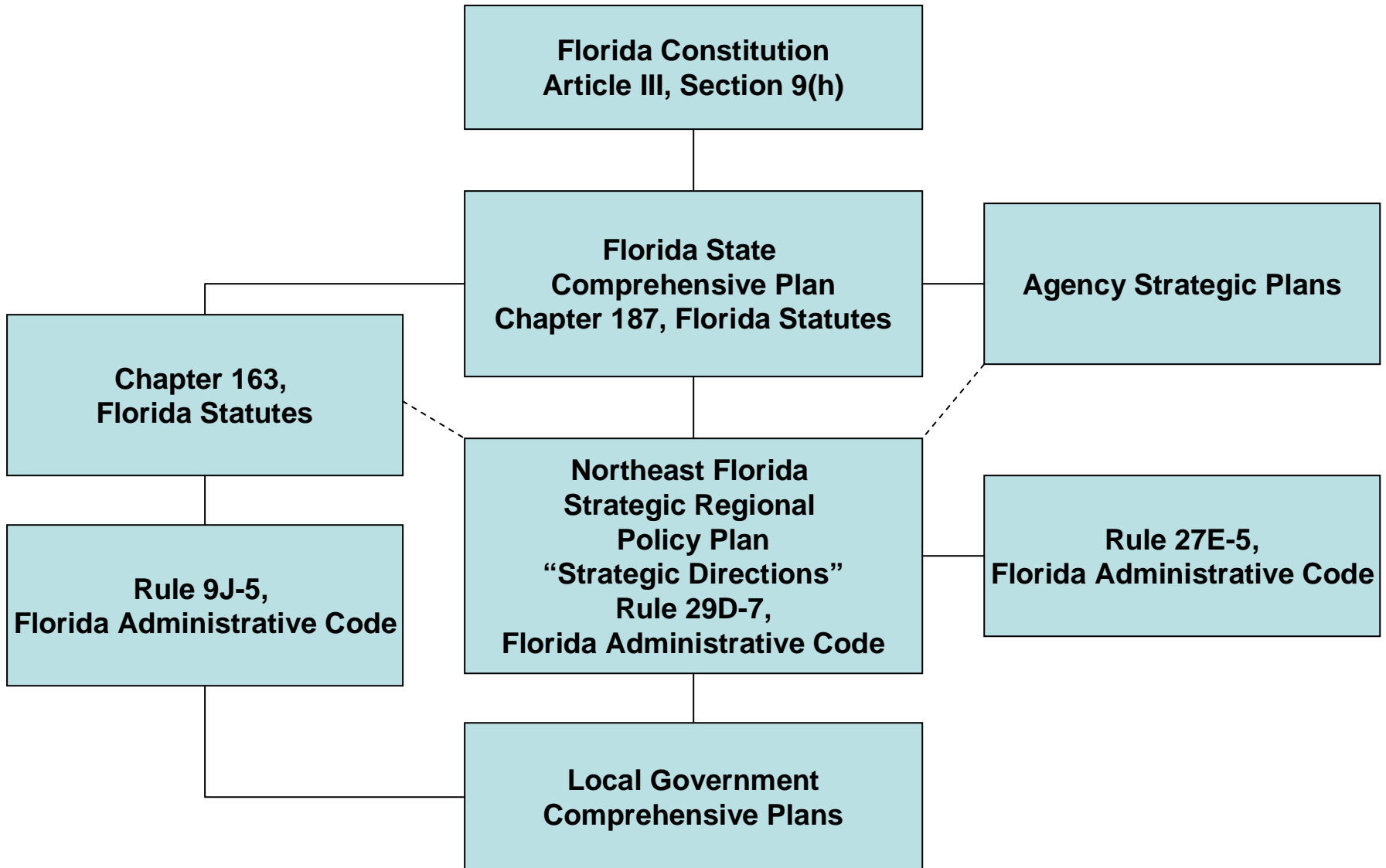

# Requirements of SRPP's

- Goals and Policies to cover, at a minimum, five content areas
  - Affordable Housing
  - Economic Development
  - Emergency Preparedness
  - Natural Resources of Regional Significance
  - Transportation
  - Any other Subject deemed necessary by the RPC

# Requirements of SRPP's

- Identify and address significant regional resources and facilities
- May not establish binding level of service standards
- Natural resources to be identified by specific geographic location, scale 1:100,000
- A plan for the Region, not merely the Regional Planning Council
- May recommend minimum density guidelines and investment strategies for transportation where growth is desired
- Must enter into a MOU with the Health Planning Council

# Purpose and Effect of SRPP

- Basis for Decision Making by the RPC
- Basis for Review of DRIs
- Review of Comp Plans limited to:
  - Effects on regional resources and facilities identified in the SRPP
  - Extra-jurisdictional Impacts
  - And inconsistency with SRPP shall not be the sole basis for a not in compliance finding by DCA

# Amendment Process for SRPP

- Must be adopted as an Administrative Rule pursuant to Chapter 120, Florida Statutes
- Requires extensive public input
- Must be reviewed by the Executive Office of the Governor
- Must be sent to each local jurisdiction for comment
- Must adopted by 2/3 vote of the membership present constituting a quorum, and
- Must be adopted by a majority of the members of the Board
- Rule is subject to the full array of challenges available under 120
- EAR to be developed every 5 years – reviewed by EOG

# Next Steps

- Review each element of the SRPP with the Board over the next 5 months
- Work with the Regional Community Institute to develop a Regional Vision that will, at a minimum, address the five elements of the SRPP – tentative completion date September 2011
- Begin the process to amend the SRPP – tentative completion in 2013
