A forum for Flagler Line corridor cities, counties, agencies, business advocates, and others has been scheduled for Thursday, January 5, 2012 at Cocoa City Hall. Representatives of the Florida Department of Transportation, FEC Railway, and Amtrak have been invited to provide updates regarding key project components.

The Flagler Line project proposes to reintroduce passenger transit on the Florida East Coast rail corridor from Jacksonville to West Palm Beach, with service continuing south to Miami. Eight new stations are proposed, including St. Augustine, Daytona Beach, Titusville, Cocoa/Rockledge, Melbourne, Vero Beach, Fort Pierce, and Stuart along with rail improvements in Jacksonville, West Palm Beach, and Miami.
