MINUTES

A meeting of the Northeast Florida Regional Council (NEFRC) Personnel, Budget, and Finance Policy Committee was held on Thursday, **July 8, 2010**, at 9:00 a.m., at the American Lung Association, 6852 Belfort Oaks Place, Jacksonville, Florida 32216. **Chairman Williams** called the meeting to order with the following members present representing a quorum:

*Approval of Minutes

Chairman Williams called for a motion on the June 3, 2010 minutes. Councilman Bishop moved approval, seconded by Mr. Fish; motion passed unanimously.

*May 2010 Financial Report

Ms. Starling reported that the Council posted a net income of \$7,068 for the month of May with a year-to-date net loss of \$22,956. Revenues for the month were \$523,496 and expenses were \$516,428. Ms. Starling stated that additional income was recognized from remaining funds in the DCA contract was utilized to fund the Regional Visioning effort, therefore, a loss was not incurred. A brief discussion followed.

Chairman Williams called for a motion on the May 2010 Financial Report. Commissioner Eubanks moved approval, seconded by Mr. Fish; motion passed unanimously.

FY 2010/2011 Proposed Budget

Ms. Starling stated that, by Interlocal Agreement, the Council is required to pass the FY 2010/2011 budget by July 15th; however, it does not become operational until October 1st. Ms. Starling provided the Committee with an overview of the proposed budget for Fiscal Year 2010/2011, which is same as was presented at the last Committee meeting. A brief discussion followed.

Chairman Williams called for a motion on the FY 2010/2011 Proposed Budget. Mr. Fish moved approval, seconded by Mr. Sgroi; motion passed unanimously.

Interoperable Emergency Communications Grant Program (IECGP) Contract Authorization

Mr. Jeff Alexander provided background information on the IECGP, the scope of work and funding source. He indicated that the Northeast Florida Regional Council will be contracting with some of the

other Regional Councils to conduct exercises across the State of Florida. He is requesting this Committee's approval to allow the Chief Executive Officer, Brian Teeple, to enter into contract with the Regional Councils with an average amount of \$150,000. A brief discussion followed.

Chairman Williams called for a motion on the Interoperable Emergency Communications Grant Program (IECGP) Contract Authorization. Commissioner Eubanks moved approval, seconded by Councilman Bishop; motion passed unanimously.

Mr. Taylor provided members detail information about the building flood that occurred on June 24, 2010, which included reconstruction plans, providing for tenant meeting room and other needs, and Regional Council meetings for August, if reconstruction is delayed.

Next Meeting Date and Location

The next meeting is scheduled for Thursday, August 5, 2010, at 9:00 a.m., at the American Lung Association, 6852 Belfort Oaks Place, Jacksonville, Florida 32216 (unless otherwise noticed).
