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## MINUTES

A meeting of the Personnel, Budget & Finance Committee was held on Thursday, October 5, 2017, at 9:30 a.m. at the Northeast Florida Regional Council, 100 Festival Park Avenue, Jacksonville, FL 32202. **Chair Register** called the meeting to order with the following members present:

Present: James Bennett, Michael Bourre, Roxanne Horvath, Darryl Register, Catherine Robinson, and George Spicer

Staff Present: Donna Starling, Brian Teeple and Sheron Forde

### \* Approval of Minutes

**Chair Register called for a motion on the minutes. Commissioner Spicer motioned to approve the August 3, 2017 Committee meeting minutes; seconded by Commissioner Bennett. Motion carried.**

### Invitation to Speak

**Chair Register** announced that the public is welcome to speak on any item that is brought before the Committee.

### \*July 2017 Financial Report

Staff reported that for the month of July 2017 the Council's net income was \$17,024 and a year-to-date net income of \$93,157; excluding building sale proceeds.

**Chair Register called for a motion. Commissioner Bennett motioned to approve the July 2017 Financial Report; seconded by Commissioner Spicer. Motion carried.**

### \*August 2017 Financial Report

Staff stated that for the month of August 2017 the Council's net income was \$18,601 and a year-to-date net income of \$111,757; excluding building sale proceeds.

**Chair Register called for a motion. Commissioner Bennett motioned to approve the August 2017 Financial Report; seconded by Commissioner Spicer. Motion carried.**

### NEFRC Audit Schedule

Ms. Starling informed the Members of the upcoming year-end audit schedule for fiscal year 2016/2017. Provided the State releases the pension liability information in a timely manner, the Auditors, Carrs, Riggs & Ingram, will present the audit at the February 2018 meeting.

Mr. Teeple stated that this will be the last year with the current auditors and that the Council will be going out to bid following the conclusion of the audit. A brief discussion followed.

*President Horvath, Mayor Robinson and Mr. Bourre arrived following their 8:30a Committee meeting.*

Programming Discretionary Revenue from Building Sale Discussion

Mr. Teeple informed the Members of the Economic Development Administration's award of \$150,000 grant, a joint effort with JaxUSA and CareerSource, to update the Regional Development Strategy. Staff provided an overview of the Committee's past actions regarding the use of discretionary funds to assist in Regional programs: \$25,000 towards the EDA grant award, and \$25,000 towards a Regional Evacuation Study. Mr. Teeple stated that there is a new opportunity to assist Nassau County; however, the effort would serve the entire Region, by developing a Fiscal Impact Model. He is seeking and recommending that the Council commit \$25,000 for this purpose. Additionally, he is requesting a \$50,000 commitment to fund a Disaster Recovery Coordinator position for a two-year period with the EDA committing \$200,000. If the Disaster Recovery Coordinator position is not funded by the EDA, the Council's funds would remain untouched. Discussion followed.

**Chair Register called for a motion. Mr. Bourre motioned to commit \$25,000 towards the Fiscal Impact Model and \$50,000 towards the Disaster Recovery Coordinator position if the EDA grant is awarded to the Council; seconded by President Horvath. Motion carried.**

Staff was asked to provide the Members with a scope of work for the Disaster Recovery Coordinator position. Mr. Teeple agreed to do so.
