

The Regional Award for Excellence in Public Safety

Purpose

To recognize an individual, entity, or specific project whose primary focus has been to improve the safety of the public or to educate the public on matters of personal, family, business, or community preparedness for disaster.

Criteria

For individuals or entities:

Consideration will be given to nominees based on:

- 1) overall vision for the future of public safety or regional response planning;
- 2) on-going commitment to the field of public safety;
- 3) individual leadership provided to the Northeast Florida community within the public safety field; or
- 4) demonstrated accomplishments in the field of natural or man-made disaster response or preparedness planning.

For public safety projects:

Consideration will be given to projects completed, implemented, or ongoing which have demonstrated success in:

- 1) providing a new or improved training option for responders;
- 2) improving or promoting community education for individual preparedness, business response and recovery, or governmental response and recovery; or
- 3) developing, implementing, enhancing or expanding a community mitigation project or program that significantly reduces the community vulnerability or hazards.
