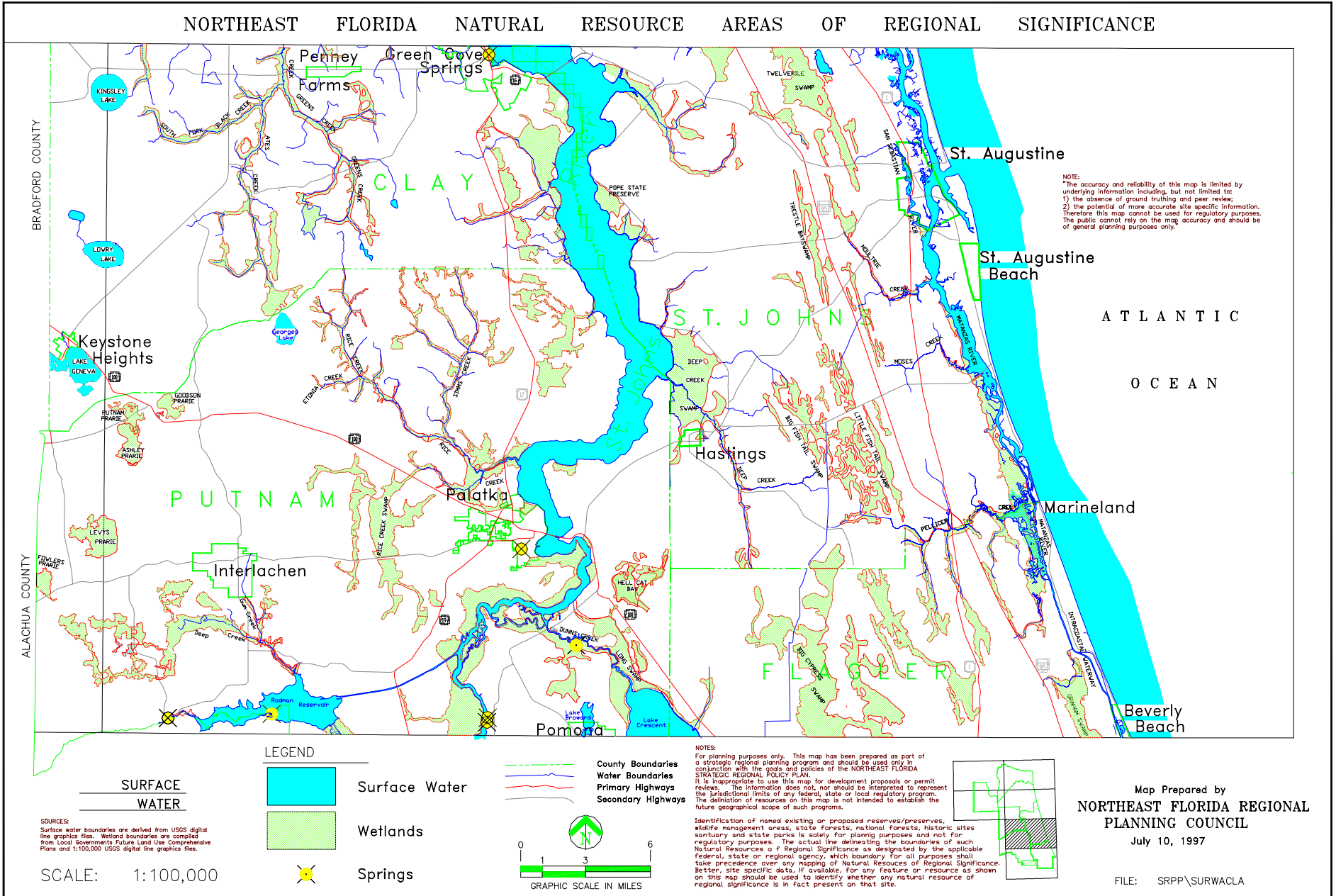


MAP 4.7 Surface Water - Clay Area
