DESCRIPTION OF AMENDMENT

This large scale amendment seeks to change text in the City of Jacksonville’s Comprehensive Plan to amend various goals, objectives, and polities of the Capital Improvements Element (CIE), Conservation and Coastal Management Element (CCME), Future Land Use Element (FLUE), Infrastructure Element (IE), and Intergovernmental Coordination Element (ICE). The text amendment is in response to the state requirement to adopt a state-mandated 10-year water supply facilities work plan into the Comprehensive Plan following the approval of an updated regional water supply plan.
