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

The Northeast Florida Regional Economic Asset Map provides a comprehensive visualization of the region's most critical economic drivers and infrastructure. It highlights:

- <u>Educational Institutions</u> Universities, colleges, and technical schools that foster workforce development and innovation.
- Research Facilities Centers of innovation that support industry advancement and technology advancement.
- <u>Community Redevelopment Areas (CRAs)</u> Targeted zones for revitalization and investment.
- <u>Federal Opportunity Zones</u> An economic development tool that allows people to invest in distressed areas in the United States.
- <u>State-Designated Brownfield Areas</u> Areas designated for environmental cleanup and redevelopment.
- <u>Transportation Assets</u> Includes airports, seaports, railroads, and major roadways that facilitate regional connectivity and commerce.
