Supporting the Designation of the month of April as Water Conservation Month

WHEREAS, water is a basic and essential need of every living creature; and

WHEREAS, the Northeast Florida Regional Council is working together with the State of Florida, the St. Johns River Water Management District, local governments and water supply utilities to increase awareness about the importance of water conservation; and

WHEREAS, April is typically a dry month when water demands increase; and

WHEREAS, the Northeast Florida Regional Council encourages and supports water conservation through its Strategic Regional Policy Plan, and in the operation of its activities and facilities; and

WHEREAS, water conservation can be an effective tool to delay or eliminate the need to develop costly alternative water sources and maintain collegiality among Florida's local governments; and

WHEREAS, every business, industry, school, resident and visitor can help by conserving water and thus promote a healthy economy and community.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Northeast Florida Regional Council supports the designation of April 2014 as Water Conservation Month and encourages Northeast Florida residents, visitors and businesses to help protect our precious water resources by practicing water conservation measures and becoming more aware of the need to conserve water.
