St. Johns River to Sea Loop Alliance

WHEREAS, the St. Johns River-to-Sea Loop constitutes an integral portion of the East Coast Greenway that connects Florida with Maine, and as well overlaps the Coast-to-Coast Trail through most of its Volusia County and Brevard County route, thereby ensuring added marketing opportunities for use of the Loop, and

WHEREAS, The St. Johns River-to-Sea Loop Alliance (SJR2C), incorporated in 2016, is a nonprofit Florida corporation; and

WHEREAS, the Alliance works to generate trail use and focus sustainable development throughout its corridor; and

WHEREAS, the Alliance supports the commitment of Florida DOT under its SUN Trails program to fund the trail development; and

WHEREAS, the Alliance is an important regional initiative putting people more closely in touch with where they find themselves when touring the Loop; and

WHEREAS, the Alliance is arranging meetings with city and county governing boards to ensure broad popular support for the Loop including its use for transportation, recreation and tourism; and

WHEREAS, the Alliance will work with stakeholders in branding and marketing efforts across Northeast and East Central Florida; and

WHEREAS, the NEFRC coordinates closely with the East Central Florida Regional Planning Council on cross region projects; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Northeast Florida Regional Council supports the efforts of the St. Johns River-to-Sea Loop Alliance and will work with them and the East Central Florida Regional Planning Council to secure funding, assist with data and other areas of need, as resources allow.
